

***WINE proposal for co-operation with working group 3A ‘ Societal Impact of Women’s Studies’
Budapest, 2 June 2007**

1. Members of WINE within Athena are committed to making available their expertise in the field of information gathering, dissemination and information technology to strengthen the outcomes of the working group 3A ‘ Societal Impact of Women’s Studies’
2. WINE will function as an autonomous sub-group of working group 3A and, in consultation with the members of group 3A, we would like to identify concrete areas for co-operation as the 3A working plan evolves
3. We recommend the 3A working group co-ordinators establish a discussion list, including the members of 3A and WINE, to facilitate open discussion on future agendas and all issues of the working plan and to enhance communication between all members
4. We recommend that future meetings begin with a joint session followed by separate WINE and 3A meetings and conclude with a joint gathering to exchange information and summarise results
5. We will gather information and create new resources (such as statistics, bibliographies, calendars of events, expert databases, directories of contacts, etc) to actively support the outcomes of working group 3A
6. We will disseminate the outputs of working group 3A in our respective languages and Within our home communities
7. We will play an active role in contributing to the expert database hosted by RoSa and explore avenues to enhance that database by linking it to other existing expert databases such as those developed by KILDEN, KVINFO, Minna and IIAV
8. We will use our local and national networks and contacts to identify new non academic partners within our regions and we propose the development of joint guidelines, in dialogue within group 3A, to support this activity
9. We recommend that the Athena website and newsletter are used to communicate all progress and outputs of the working group 3A, including the sub group WINE.
10. The current WINE website will be relocated within the Athena website and linked to working group 3A. The WINE website group will take responsibility for keeping the WINE website up to date
11. We propose that one of the working group co-ordinators participates in the discussions and meetings of WINE to ensure a strong match between the work of our groups
