**Activities 2006:**

*Gender equality in the Nordic countries*, a 10 ECTS “elevator course”, given at the same time on BA and MA levels at The Centre for Women’s Studies and Gender Research (SKK), University of Oslo. The course is given in English and has mainly international students. Spring and autumn.

In cooperation with the Faculty of philosophy, University of Montenegro I organised ‘Antivari summer academy’ in gender studies. 21 students from 7 West Balkan countries, including Kosovo, participated.

From August project leader for a cooperation programme between University of Oslo and University of Montenegro with the title ‘Gender, violence and democracy in Western Balkans’ (GVD-WB), funded by the Research Council of Norway.
